Agnes of Rome (c. 291-304)

Agnes was only about 12 or 13 when she was arrested in Rome for refusing to give up her Christian faith or marry someone who didn't follow Jesus. She boldly declared her faith in Christ even though it cost her life.



A common quote attributed to her life is -"I am a servant of Christ; I cannot deny Him." Scripture says: Matthew 5:10 – "Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Reflection Questions:


- · What does it say about Agnes that she stood firm in her faith at such a young age?



This month in our First Kids ministry, we are focusing on what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. A disciple is simply someone who learns from Jesus and tries to live the way He taught. Disciple might sound like a big word, but really it

comes down to some simple and powerful choices:

loving God loving others following Jesus in our everyday lives.

For our children, being a disciple might look like showing kindness on the playground, including someone who feels left out, praying for a friend, or listening to God's Word with an open heart. For parents, discipleship is about guiding our children toward Jesus while also continuing to grow in faith ourselves.

Together, families can learn side by side, helping each other to put faith into action.

Jesus didn't just tell His disciples how to live—He walked with them, shared meals, taught lessons through stories, and showed them how to serve others. In the same way, we are inviting our children to learn by doing. Each week, we will practice simple ways to follow Jesus, from memorizing Scripture to serving others with love.

Parents, your role is so important! When children see faith lived out at home—in prayer, in forgiveness, in gratitude—they begin to understand what discipleship looks like beyond Sunday mornings.

Our prayer is that this season of study will not only teach our children about being disciples but will also inspire families to walk more closely with Jesus together. Let's encourage one another, celebrate small steps of faith, and remember that Jesus promises....

"Follow me, and I will show you..." (Matthew 4:19).


