Families in our community are struggling to find time together as busy schedules overwhelm them. First Kids gather on Wednesdays until 5:15pm. Parents are picking them up but most likely haven't gotten home yet to begin dinner prep. They may be on the way to another activity and are picking up dinner in the drive-thru.

The Table provides a gathering space for families on the run to slow down and have a home cooked, nutritious mid-week meal together. Families will register in advance (weekly) and pay \$5 (total) to reserve their space for a family meal. All community families are invited

Our friends who attend Food & Fellowship face many hurdles. Job training, employment skills, and mentorship can help. First UMC will provide a 12-week training and mentorship program for local men and women who currently do not have stable housing in order to provide them with job skills and experience.

A team of mentors will run the program - people with kitchen experience and peer support. We will use curriculum that covers kitchen basics and an includes job skills training. Upon completion of the program, participants will receive a certificate and letter of recommendation for potential employment. Participants will join in dinner weekly and can "shop" at the hygiene center.

In Loving Memory of Gene Walker Faithful Servant and Co-Director of the First Food Pantry



The First Food Pantry began serving our community in December 2010. From its earliest days, Gene and Marilyn Walker were a constant and faithful presence. Always willing to lend a hand, they gave their time generously—volunteering on distribution days, handing out food boxes, stocking shelves, and packing countless boxes for families in need.

Following Marilyn's passing in 2015, Gene continued his service with quiet dedication. He made frequent trips to Feeding America Southwest Virginia in Abingdon, bringing back pallets of food for the pantry. He was always ready to help-unloading and loading food at the storage building, packing boxes, and stepping in wherever there was a need.

In 2024, Gene Walker and Ernie Catron were named co-directors of the First Food Pantry. Together, they formed a strong and dependable team. They carefully compared prices before purchasing food, took turns picking up donations from the Marion Walmart, and ensured that the pantry tables outside the Fellowship Hall were wellstocked for families in need. Their thoughtful planning and teamwork made distribution days run smoothly and efficiently.

In May of this year, Gene passed away unexpectedly. His loss is deeply felt by his family, his church family, and all who served with him at the First Food Pantry. Gene's quiet leadership, tireless work, and compassionate heart made a lasting impact on everyone who knew him.

We are profoundly grateful for Gene Walker's years of faithful service and loving dedication. He leaves behind a legacy of generosity and care that will not be forgotten.

Thank you, Gene, for everything. You are dearly missed.
